What services are Provided by Karabi Youth and Family Support Services

Advice and support:

This involves a one off consultation for young people and their families, so that they can explore their options and seek the assistances they need to achieve their goals.

On going Support through Case Management:

This involves making an appointment with a Karabi Youth and Family Support Worker. With the Support Worker a young person can explore their options in a safe, fun, friendly and respectful environment. The Support Worker can then support the young person and their families to plan the steps to achieving their goals and link them with supportive pathways.

Skilled Focused Training and programs:

This includes programs which young people build develop life skills needed for a healthy and safe future. Such life skills include relationship development, self-help strategies, career and employment and psychosocial support. How can Karabi Youth and Family support help young people?

Karabi Youth and Family Support can help young people with:

- Achieving their goals.
- Providing links to information and services that assist young people in achieve their goals.
- Developing case plans with young people.
- Strengthening, their relationship with family, friends and the community.
- Providing support with education, employment and training opportunities.
- Support young people in coping with hard times.
- Provide a Safe, Friendly, Fun and Respectful environment.
- Supporting young people in developing skills that they need in taking control

Who can get involved?

Families with young people who are experiencing vulnerabilities that could impact on their safety, happiness and wellbeing if not addressed.

How can you get involved?

There are two ways young people can get involved:

- You can make a self referral, which involves calling or popping into one of the Karabi Neighbourhood Cottages and making an appointment with the Karabi Youth and Family support Case Worker.
- Referrals can be made from either a parent, teacher, social worker or counsellor.


