A weekly supported play group for families in Western Sydney



SDN Playlinks provides a safe environment where children and parents can participate in play and learning activities run by trained staff who understand children's development and play-based learning. SDN Playlinks has two components: supported play groups and in-home support.

We can help:

- ▶ children aged 0–5 years and their parents
- ▶ children and families from culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) backgrounds, refugees, families living in vulnerable circumstances and Aboriginal families
- ▶ families who would like to help their children learn to communicate, move and play
- ▶ families who would like someone to talk to about getting help for their children.

We can help you to:

- ▶ spend quality time with your children
- ▶ understand how children learn and develop, and what to expect at different ages and stages of development

- ▶ connect and socialise with other families
- ▶ support your child's communication through play-based activities
- ▶ understand your child's behaviour and help them to interact with others
- ▶ connect with other services and activities for children and families in your community.

In-home support

In-home support is an optional component of Playlinks for eligible families.

- ▶ home visits are done during school holidays when groups are not run.
- ▶ we help parents to set goals and to measure the outcomes.
